* Unlimited events in athlete age group only. Athletes aged 5 to 9 years receive a Participation Medallion and Result Certificate # 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Medallions awarded in each age group. Athletes 14 and above may compete in their own age group or Open.

IMPORTANT NOTES – READ CAREFULLY

1. Events will commence at 8am – Saturday 1st June and will finish approximately 2.30pm Sunday 2nd June, 2019
2. Age is ACTUAL AGE IN YEARS as at 31st December 2019 - Masters Athletes will be age on the 1st day of competition
3. School/College or University athletes competing at the carnival will compete for their school and compete in their SCHOOL SPORTS UNIFORM.
4. Senior Club athletes should wear their Club uniform and ANQ number - Open Athletes not registered with an ANQ club are required to pay an \$20 Day Registration fee (unless exempt as in clause 4 above) and complete a Day Registration Form, and will be required to report to the ANQ Administration Office at the Townsville Sports Reserve prior to their first event and will be allocated a temporary registration number.
5. Nominations fees Non-Refundable.
6. There are no restrictions on the number of events a competitor may enter in his/her own age group. Athletes may only compete in their own age group and Athletics with a Disability (PARA) enter in own age division. Athletes 5yrs to 9yrs – 3 attempts at each field event: Athletes 10yrs to U18 and Masters 3 attempts at each field event plus 1 additional attempt for top 8. Athletes U20 & Open 6 attempts at field events.
7. ENTRIES CLOSE at midnight 22nd May, 2019
8. NO LATE ENTRIES and ENTRIES CANNOT BE CHANGED ON DAY.
9. All competitors are automatically considered for age medallions, age trophies and event trophies. Individual event trophies will not be awarded unless acceptable standards are achieved.
10. Trophies are awarded for the top PRIMARY and SECONDARY schools.
11. Nominations to be lodged online at <https://sgallcomers2019.eventdesq.com> Full payment of registration fees at time of the online nomination.
12. A Program Timetable will be available on the ANQ Website from Wednesday 29th May, 2019
13. Shoes must be worn for all throwing events and highly recommended for all other track events.
14. Spike shoes may be worn in age groups 10yrs and above. 10-12 yr are only permitted to wear spikes in laned events, jumps and javelin. Year 13 and up laned and unlaned events, jumps and javelin. Spikes to be 7mm maximum tartan. Only exceptions are 9mm for javelin and high jump.
15. Pole Vaulters MUST supply their own Pole and be competent at the event.
