Drafting		
		Athletes are only allowed to draft with other athletes in their own race and class. Drafting is defined as seeking a performance advantage by following another athlete within a distance of less than 5 metres for 400 metres. Umpires should make a note of athletes drafting. If an accident occurs later in the race, you have evidence of carelessness or poor technique by an athlete.
